RE: 2009-2010 Guidance Priority List

Ladies and Gentleman:

The National Association of Bond Lawyers ("NABL") respectfully suggests the following items for inclusion in the 2009–2010 Guidance Priority List. Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and sections amended by the *American Recovery and Reinvestment Act* ("ARRA"), Pub. L. No. 111-05, are so indicated.

- 1. Guidance on stripping tax credits from tax credit bonds under section 54A(i).
- 2. Final regulations on public approval under section 147.
- 3. New proposed regulations defining solid waste disposal facilities under section 142.
- 4. Guidance on treatment of related 501(c)(3) organizations for purposes of the \$30,000,000 bank eligible limit under section 265(b)(3) as amended by ARRA.
- 5. Confirmation that the exemption from Alternative Minimum Tax under section 57(a)(5) as amended by ARRA for bonds issued in 2009 and 2010 applies to refundings of bonds issued in 2004–08 to refund bonds issued before 2004.
- 6. Guidance as to Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds and Recovery Zone Facility Bonds under sections 1400U-2 and 1400U-3 as amended by ARRA.
- 7. Final regulations on allocation and accounting under section 141.
- 8. Amendment to the definition of a state or local bond opinion in § 10.35(b)(9) of Circular 230 to deal with opinions to issuers of direct payment Build America Bonds.

These items are suggested as priority items in the current unusual circumstance in which the Administration's energetic and welcome response to ARRA, and the unquestioned need for continued response, have strained available resources. These items are not listed in an internal priority order.
